

AHIDF (Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund)

The Union Cabinet recently extended the **Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund** (AHIDF) till 2025-26.

About the Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF):

- The AHIDF is a Central Sector Scheme designed to boost investments in dairy and meat processing, animal feed plants, breed multiplication farms, waste management, and the production of veterinary vaccines and drugs.
- It will be executed by the **Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying**, with an updated outlay of **Rs 29,610.25 crore**, significantly higher than its initial **Rs 15,000 crore** setup in **2020** as part of the "**Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan**" stimulus package.
- It offers a **3% interest subvention** for **8 years** and a **2-year moratorium** on loans of up to **90%** from Scheduled Banks, **NCDC**, **NABARD**, and **NDDB**, with
- Government offers a **credit guarantee** to **MSMEs** and Dairy Cooperatives up to **25%** of the credit borrowed from the **Credit Guarantee Fund (CGF)** managed by **NABARD**.
- Eligible entities include **individuals**, **Dairy Cooperatives**, **Private Companies**, **FPOs**, **MSMEs**, and **Section 8 companies**, aiming to mitigate Covid-19's adverse impact through the **Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan** fiscal stimulus package.

Objectives of the Scheme:

- Increase milk and meat processing capacity.
- Promote product diversification.
- Provide better **market access** for unorganized rural producers.
- Enhance **price realization** for producers.
- Ensure the availability of quality milk and meat products for consumers.
- Address **malnutrition** by providing protein-enriched food.
- Generate employment and entrepreneurship.
- Boost **exports** in the milk and meat sector.
- Provide quality animal feed at affordable prices.





Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund

AHIDF has been granted Rs 15,000 crore to establish:

- Dairy processing and product diversification infrastructure
- Meat processing and product diversification infrastructure
- Animal feed plant
- Breed Improvement Technology and Breed Multiplication Farms
- Setting up of Veterinary Vaccine and Drugs Production Facilities
- Animal Waste to Wealth Management

Achievements of the AHIDF:

Since its launch, the AHIDF has significantly increased processing capacities, adding 141.04 lakh
litre per day of milk processing capacity, 79.24 lakh ton of feed processing capacity, and 9.06
lakh ton of meat processing capacity, marking a 2-4% increase in processing capacity in the
dairy, meat, and animal feed sector.
