About Chondrostereum purpureum:

- Silver leaf is a fungal disease of trees caused by the fungus plant pathogen Chondrostereum purpureum.
- Its name is taken from the **progressive silvering of leaves** on affected branches.
- It attacks most species of the rose family Rosaceae, particularly the genus Prunus.
- It is progressive and often fatal.
- It is spread by airborne spores landing on freshly exposed sapwood.
- Cherries and plums are pruned in summer, when spores are least likely to be present and when the disease is visible.
- Silver Leaf can also happen on poming fruits like apples and pears.
