### Forest and Climate Leaders' Partnership (FCLP)

Twenty-Six countries and the EU are announcing a commitment to join the Forest and Climate Leaders' Partnership at the Forest and Climate Leaders' Summit at COP27.

- FCLP is a **voluntary partnership** of 26 countries.
- It was **launched by world leaders** including the **EU Commission President, UK Prime Minister and the leaders of France, Ghana, Congo, Colombia, and Germany**.
- **Aim:** To deliver the commitment made at COP26 to halt and reverse forest loss and land degradation by 2030 and deliver sustainable development and promoting an inclusive rural transformation.
- The Partnership **unites action by government, business and community leaders**.
- Every member is committing to play a leadership role to drive forward at least one of the FCLP's action areas, which are:
  - International collaboration on the sustainable land use economy;
  - Mobilising public and donor finance to support implementation;
  - Shifting the private finance system;
  - Supporting Indigenous Peoples' and local communities' initiatives;
  - Strengthening and scaling carbon markets for forests; and
  - Partnerships and incentives for preserving high-integrity forests.
