- To track maritime activities, including "dark shipping," which refers to vessels that do not transmit their location or appear in tracking systems.

- Enhances the collective ability to respond to maritime threats, piracy, and natural disasters.
- Improves management of marine resources and environmental protection through shared maritime domain awareness.

Operational Aspects:

- The initiative will **integrate monitoring systems** and **share critical information** among **Quad nations**.
