
Location of Iraq

- Iraq is a federal parliamentary republic, divided into 18 governorates for local administration.
- It is situated in the heart of the **Middle East**, Iraq shares borders with **Turkey**, **Iran**, **Kuwait**, **Saudi Arabia**, **Jordan**, **and Syria**.
- The **Tigris and Euphrates rivers**, cradles of ancient **Mesopotamian civilizations**, are vital for agriculture and remain a source of regional tension due to shared water rights.
- The **Sinjar Mountains** provide refuge for minority groups, while the Zagros Mountains along the Iranian border mark a natural geographic boundary.
- Lake Razzaza, once a significant source of freshwater, is at risk of drying up, highlighting Iraq's vulnerability to water scarcity.
