A momentous step in our journey towards socio-economic rejuvenation and human development of Assam, Orunodoi scheme is the most ambitious of the series of schemes announced in the Budget of 2020-21 under the Ashtadash Mukutar Unnoyonee Maala.

Overview of the scheme:

- Orunodoi Scheme symbolizes the State Government's self-reliance, self-confidence and determination to take Assam to a path of Resurgence.
- Monthly assistance of ₹830 to marginalized households of Assam will be provided through Orunodoi Scheme for purchasing essential commodities like pulses, sugar, other nutritional items and medicines.
- This scheme is designed keeping in mind that women are the primary caretakers of the household, and therefore, the cash benefit shall be transferred to her account.
- Orunodoi, the largest ever Direct Benefit Transfer scheme, would give a choice to the poor and needy households on how they want to spend their money.

Orunodoi Scheme:

- In 2020, the Assam government launched the Orunodoi Scheme.
- Aim: To empower women and provide financial assistance to economically vulnerable families.

Benefits:

- 2800 crore rupees is reserved for the Scheme under which every year 10 thousand rupees will be given to 27 lakh **helpless families.**
- 25 lakh rupees will give per school for 200-grade schools for foundation improvement.
- Assam government is to give **free sterile napkins** to young ladies in sixth to twelfth norms government and government-helped schools.
- Only ladies will be the recipient of the plan to guarantee its appropriate use by the family.

Eligible Beneficiaries:

- Families with widows
- Unmarried women
- · Families with a divyang member
- · Families having a divorcee woman
- · Poor families not having ration cards for free rice
- Poor families with the National Food Security Scheme (NFSS) cards
- Families who own two or three-wheelers, and tractors under self-help groups.
