About Project Seabird:

• The project was initiated in **1986** by the Indian Navy for the establishment of the **3rd major naval** base in Karwar, Karnataka.

Phase I:

- It was completed in 2011.
- It was designed to accommodate 10 ships.
- It included comprehensive infrastructure such as a breakwater, pier, ship lift, repair yard, logistics, and storage facilities.

Phase IIA:

- It focuses on **eco-friendly infrastructure compliant** with the **Indian Green Building Council** (IGBC) and **Ministry of Environment**, **Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) guidelines**.
 - **IGBC:** It is part of the **Confederation of Indian Industry** and works to facilitate India to become a **global leader in the sustainable built environment** by 2025.
- Enhancement to accommodate 32 ships and submarines.
- Introduction of over 6 kilometers of berthing space and an iconic Covered Dry Berth.
- Construction of about **10,000 dwelling units** across four townships for various personnel.
- Development of a green field dual-use Naval Air Station with a 2700 m runway.
