About Sonai Rupai Wildlife Sanctuary:

- It is a protected area located in the state of **Assam**.
- It is located along the foothills of the **Great Himalayan Range**.
- It was declared as a sanctuary in 1998.
- It is an **Important Bird Area** recognized by **Birdlife International**.
- Four rivers flow through the sanctuary: Gabharu, Gelgeli, Sonai and Rupai.
- It forms **Sonitpur Kameng Elephant Reserve** with Nameri National Park.
- Flora:
 - Mammals: Tiger, lesser cats, elephant, gaur, wild boar, pygmy hog, swamp deer and barking deer.
 - Birds: White-winged wood duck, hornbill, pelican, and various migratory birds.
 - Reptiles: python, Russell's viper.
- Fauna: Tropical evergreen, semi-evergreen and moist deciduous forests.
