# **Major Highlights**

- The **ASEAN India Business Council (AIBC)** has made recommendations to improve the ASEAN India economic partnership.
- They welcomed the launch of ASEAN-India Trade in Goods Agreement (AITIGA) Upgrade Negotiations, mutual recognition of COVID-19 vaccination, vaccine production etc. for postpandemic recovery responses.
  - Scope of the Review of AITIGA was made more user-friendly, simple, and trade facilitative for businesses.
- Discussion included the successful outcomes of the **Twelfth World Trade Organization** (WTO) **Ministerial Conference** held in June 2022 **in Geneva, Switzerland.**

# **About Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN)**

- ASEAN is a 10-member regional grouping of South-East Asian Nations.
- Itwas established with the signing of the ASEAN Declaration (Bangkok Declaration) in 1967.
- Aim- To promote political and social stability amid rising tensions among the Asia-Pacific's postcolonial states.



- **Members:** Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.
- Dialogue partners of ASEAN: Australia, Canada, China, EU, India, Japan, Republic of Korea, New Zealand, Russia, UK and US
- India become ASEAN's dialogue partner in 5th ASEAN Summit in Bangkok in 1995.
- The official motto of ASEAN is **One Vision**, **One Identity**, **One Community**.

# **Objective**

- To accelerate economic growth, social progress and cultural development in the region
- To promote regional peace and stability through abiding respect for justice and the rule of law in the relationship among countries in the region and adherence to the principles of the United Nations Charter.
- To **promote active collaboration and mutual assistance** on matters of common interest in the economic, social, cultural, technical, scientific and administrative fields.
- To **provide assistance in the form of training** and research facilities in the educational, professional, technical and administrative spheres.
- To promote Southeast Asian studies and maintain close and beneficial cooperation with existing international and regional organisations.

#### **Fundamental Principles**

- Mutual respect for the independence, sovereignty, equality, territorial integrity, and national identity of all nations
- The right of every state to lead its national existence free from external interference, subversion or coercion
- Non-interference in the internal affairs of one another
- Settlement of differences or disputes by peaceful manner
- Renunciation of the threat or use of force
- Effective cooperation among themselves
